Applications must be received through the mail or by email no later than close of business on the last business day of March each year

If successful you will need to purchase a nonrefundable capture permit.

Season Dates: Take season begins annually on May 1st and ends on August 31st

Area Open: Statewide – Taking of wild raptors is prohibited within the boundaries of all National Parks in Utah and on all Utah State Parks.

Restrictions and Requirements:

Other restrictions may apply on some public and private lands. Successful applicants should check with landowners and land management agencies for more information prior to capturing or attempting to capture eyas or passage age Peregrine Falcons from these lands. You must obtain prior written approval from the landowner or authorized agent for entry onto private lands.

1. Only General and Master Class falconers may apply to take eyas or passage age peregrine falcons in accordance with Sections R657-20-11 and R657-20-12 and as provided in this rule.
2. Application procedures for taking eyas or passage Peregrine Falcons are provided in Section R657-20-12 and R657-20-13.
3. The peregrine falcon take season begins annually on May 1st and ends on August 31st.
4. The number of permits issued to take peregrine falcons will be set by the Division annually.
5. One non-resident take permit will be issued annually. If that permit is not applied for, it will be made available to resident falconers.
6. Any remaining permits that are not applied for will be made available to resident and nonresident falconers on a first-come first-served basis.
7. Issued permits will allow take of one eyas or passage age Peregrine Falcon.
8. An eyas peregrine falcon may not be removed from its aerie prior to 10 days of age.
9. Peregrine falcon aeries may not be entered when young are 28 days or more of age.
10. A peregrine falcon that is marked with a research band such as a colored band with alphanumeric codes or some other research marking attached must be immediately released.
11. Research band numbers and location and date of capture must be reported to the Division and the Federal Bird Banding Laboratory (1-800-327-2263) within 5 business days of the date of capture.
