

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES  
TO THE UTAH FISHING PROCLAMATION  
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING  
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH 2015**

I, Greg Sheehan, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare and emergency amendment to the 2015 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

**GUNLOCK RESERVOIR (Washington County):**

The daily bag and possession limit has been raised to:

- 12 Largemouth Bass (No size restrictions)
- Crappie – No Limit
- Blue Gill – No Limit
- Bullhead Catfish – No Limit
- Channel Catfish – 16

Gunlock Reservoir will be treated this fall by the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources to remove smallmouth bass. Smallmouth bass present a threat to native species in the Santa Clara and Virgin River systems. Following the treatment largemouth bass, crappie and blue gill will be restocked.

These changes are effective May 12, 2015 and will remain in effect until January 1, 2015. All other rules, established in the 2015 Utah Fishing Guidebook remain in effect.
