

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES
TO THE 2015 UTAH FISHING PROCLAMATION
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH**

I, Gregory Sheehan, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2015 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

Mill Creek Canyon (From Fee Booth Station to Mill Creek Dam (boardwalk area just above Porter Fork), Salt Lake County):

- INCREASE the daily bag and possession limit to eight (8) fish

This change is effective May 15, 2015 and will remain in effect until January 1, 2016.

Native Bonneville cutthroat trout (BCT) are being restored into Mill Creek Canyon. Beginning in September 2015, in preparation to reintroduce BCT into Mill Creek, existing fish in the lower portion of the canyon will be removed from the mouth of the canyon to Mill Creek Dam near Porter Fork area. Limits are being temporarily liberalized to allow anglers to harvest fish that would otherwise be lost. Please keep in mind that some private property exists in the lower and middle section of Mill Creek Canyon. Please respect private property rights within the canyon.
