

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY CHANGES
TO THE 2015 UTAH FISHING PROCLAMATION
OF THE WILDLIFE BOARD FOR THE TAKING
OF FISH AND CRAYFISH**

I, Gregory Sheehan, by authority granted in Section 23-14-8 of the Wildlife Resources code of Utah declare an emergency amendment to the 2015 Utah Fishing Guidebook. The following has been amended:

NINE MILE RESERVOIR (San Pete County):

- INCREASE the daily bag and possession limit to eight (8) fish

This change is effective May 15, 2015 and will remain in effect until January 1, 2016.

Nine Mile Reservoir is being drained to meet irrigation demands/needs. Low to no water in the reservoir will result in the loss of fish. Limits are being temporarily liberalized to allow anglers to harvest fish that would otherwise be lost. It is anticipated that Nine Mile Reservoir will be fully operational by the spring 2016 stocking schedule.
